### **NCAC All-Sports Winter Update**

### **DEPAUW MAINTAINS ALL-SPORTS LEAD; TIGERS CLAIM FOUR TOP-FIVE FINISHES, ONE NCAC TITLE**

**CLEVELAND, OH** -- DePauw University posted four top-five finishes, including one winter championship, to maintain its lead in the race for the 2019-20 North Coast Athletic Conference All-Sports Championship.

The Tigers won their eighth [women's basketball](#) championship in the last nine years after finishing the regular season with a perfect 16-0 record against league foes, while also finishing fourth overall in [men's basketball](#), [men's swimming & diving](#) and [women's swimming & diving](#). The Tigers also finished sixth in [men's indoor track & field](#) and seventh in [women's indoor track & field](#). DePauw accumulated 40.0 total all-sport points during the winter season and holds a narrow one-and-a-half-point lead over Denison, 93.5-92.0, in the race for the coveted Dennis M. Collins All-Sports Trophy. The Big Red, who racked up 42.0 all-sports points in the winter season, won the league title in women's swimming & diving for the 10th time, posted a second-place finish in men's swimming & diving, tied for second in women's basketball and claimed third in men's indoor track & field.

Ohio Wesleyan, which captured its league-leading 16th overall crown in women's indoor track & field, placed second in men's indoor track & field and took fourth in women's basketball, sits in third with 85.0 points. Kenyon is in fourth with 79.0 points after the Lords won their league-leading 24th men's swimming & diving title, while the Ladies placed second in women's swimming & diving. Wittenberg sits in fifth just one point behind Kenyon with 78.0 points after four top-five finishes, including one NCAC title. The Tigers won their 13th crown in men's basketball, tied for second in women's basketball, placed third in women's indoor track & field and finished fourth in men's indoor track & field. Wooster is in sixth with 67.0 points after four top-five finishes, placing third in men's basketball and finishing fifth in men's swimming & diving, women's swimming & diving and women's indoor track & field. The Fighting Scots were followed by Allegheny in seventh (65.5), Oberlin in eighth (64.0), Wabash in ninth (53.0) and Hiram in 10th (20.0). Wabash picked up the final conference crown of the winter season, as the Little Giants claimed their seventh overall men's indoor track & field title; Wabash also posted top-five finishes in men's basketball and men's swimming and diving.

The All-Sports champion earns the [Dennis M. Collins All-Sports Trophy](#), given annually to the school that performs the best across the NCAC's 23 sports. Ten points are awarded for a first-place finish, nine for a second, eight for a third, and so on. Men's and women's performances are combined, exemplifying the North Coast's commitment to equity and balance among programs. Wooster won three of the first four All-Sports championships, interrupted only by Denison in year two. Ohio Wesleyan followed with a six-year run, leading to titles by Wooster (twice), Wittenberg (once), Denison (nine), OWU (twice), and then a tie between Denison and OWU in 2009. Wittenberg earned its second All-Sports title in 2010, followed by Denison in 2011 and DePauw in 2012. Denison then claimed back-to-back titles in 2013 and 2014, before DePauw regained the championship in 2015. The Big Red then reclaimed the title in the 2015-16 academic year, while DePauw recaptured the prize again in 2017 before Denison earned the title back in 2018 and then again in 2019.

Ohio Wesleyan leads the way with 157 [team championships](#) during the NCAC's 36 playing seasons. Denison is next with 151 titles, followed by Kenyon (124), Allegheny (117), Wittenberg (110), Wooster (84), DePauw (32), Wabash (27), Oberlin (23) and Hiram (2).
