## **MEET INFORMATION**

**Teams**: Albion, Baldwin-Wallace, Capital, Heidelberg, Hiram, Kenyon, Marietta, Ohio Wesleyan, West Liberty, Wittenberg

**Entries:** Enter through Direct Athletics. Please submit verifiable entry times or marks from the 2024-25 indoor or outdoor seasons. If an athlete does not have a time or mark in an event this season, you may submit a time or mark that corresponds to their early outdoor season efforts from 2024. Any entry from 2024 that places an athlete in the fast section of an event will be subject to the discretion of meet management. For the discus, hammer and shot put we will limit entries to four per school once we reach a field size of 32.

Entry Fee: \$300.00 per men's team and \$300.00 per women's team. Payment will be made through DA.

Entry Deadline: Entries will close at 7:00 PM on Wednesday, April 2.

**Seeding:** All heats and flights will be seeded according to performance. There will be prelims and finals in the throws and horizontal jumps.

**Trainers:** The training room is located under the west side of Selby Stadium. Bobby Bair (OWU athletic trainer) can be reached at 740-368-3747 should you need to contact him prior to the meet.

**Spikes:** Maximum of 1/4" pyramid exposed will be permitted on the track and javelin runway.

**Results:** Lynx will be used for timing. Results will be posted throughout the meet at the Marv Frye Timing Building. Complete results will be available after the conclusion of meet at <a href="http://www.battlingbishops.com/">http://www.battlingbishops.com/</a> and TFRRS.

**Implement Certification:** Opens at 9:30am.

Discus and Shot Put - South end of East stands in stadium

Hammer and Javelin - Long Throws venue

Please label implements with school name in advance to aid officials. Max 2 implements per competitor.

## Parking:

The parking behind the stadium will be limited to officials. Vans should park in the main Selby lot or in the lot behind the field house on the corner on Henry St. (Branch Rickey Way) and Wilmer Street. There is limited parking at the long throws venue.

Buses should drop off and load outside of the stadium, but should park at the Meek Aquatics on Henry Street. They will not be permitted to stay parked along Henry Street throughout the day. Please print the campus map (linked to in your email) to provide to your bus driver. Do not park buses behind the stadium or in the main Selby lot.

## **Drop-Off / Pick-Up:**

Do not park buses along Henry Street until your team is ready to load. Call your driver when ready. Delaware Police have given notice that they will ticket busses not actively loading.

Facility:

Pole Vault: North D area. Approaches can be made from east or west.

Long/Triple Jump: 2 runways just outside of the east stands with pits as both the north and south ends

Women's long jump board is placed at 7 feet and triple boards at 28' and 32' Men's long jump board is placed at 9 feet and triple boards at 36' and 40'.

HT / JT: Contested at the long throws field on Hayes St.

SP / DT: Located within the stadium

High Jump: Contested at the south D area.

Sprints and Hurdles can be run both directions.

The javelin and hammer facility is located on Hayes Street, less than ¼ mile from Selby Stadium. Proceed south on Branch Rickey Way and make the first left onto Hayes St. near the tennis courts. Transportation will not be provided. Parking is available at the Haycock Art Annex lot behind the Hammer/Discus cage.
